FUEL SURCHARGE TO THE COST OF THE FREIGHT RATE PER TON

Due to the volatility in the price of diesel fuel, a fuel surcharge will be **allowed on the freight rate only**. No surcharge is allowed on the cost of the material.

The price per gallon for Gulf Coast (PADD3) on-highway diesel fuel as reported by the U.S. Energy Information Administration at <http://www.eia.gov/petroleum/gasdiesel/> for Monday, August 26, 2024 is \$3.317. Should the price per gallon for Gulf Coast (PADD3) on-highway diesel fuel as reported by the U.S. Energy Information Administration at <http://www.eia.gov/petroleum/gasdiesel/> for the Monday immediately prior to the date of delivery be more than \$3.517 per gallon then a fuel surcharge allowance for the freight rate will be implemented as shown on the table listed below.

Fuel Surcharge Allowance Table

to \$3.517	0%
\$3.518 to \$3.717	5%
\$3.718 to \$3.917	10%
\$3.918 to \$4.117	15%
\$4.118 to \$4.317	20%

Should the fuel price exceed the highest price per gallon listed in the table above, the fuel surcharge allowance rate will continue to increase in 5% increments for each \$0.200 per gallon increase in accordance with the Fuel Surcharge Table listed above.

Example:

If the F.O.B. Material Price Per Ton is \$10.00 and the Freight Rate Per Ton is \$15.00 and 25 tons of material were hauled on a Tuesday and the price per gallon for Gulf Coast (PADD3) on-highway diesel fuel as reported by the U.S. Energy Information Administration at <http://www.eia.gov/petroleum/gasdiesel/> for the Monday immediately prior to the Tuesday haul date is \$3.623 then the total cost is shown below:

Fuel Surcharge/Rebate:	\$375.00 X 5%	=	<u>\$18.75</u>



E-VERIFY REQUIREMENT: In accordance with the Code of Alabama, 1975 as amended, §31-13-9, the successful bidder, “shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama and shall attest to such, by sworn affidavit signed before a notary.” Additionally, the business entity “shall provide documentation establishing that [it] is enrolled in the E-Verify program” and that during the contract period, it “shall participate in the E-Verify program and shall verify every employee that is required to be verified according to the applicable federal rules and regulations.” This section shall also apply to subcontractors. The successful bidder shall provide proof of enrollment in the E-Verify program **before** receiving a contract.

All bids should be sealed with subject matter marked plainly on the outside of envelope.
