Gentlemen:

Escambia County is taking bids for labor, equipment, materials, and any incidentals required to complete the work of the following items required for the <u>ECB-HWA-01240828 Annual Paving</u>, <u>Striping</u>, <u>and Plant Mix Bid</u>, of the County. This bid is intended to comply with the Rebuild Alabama Act, No. 2019-2, and Alabama Code Title 39, the Alabama Public Works Law. Bidders shall be required to comply with the provisions of the Rebuild Alabama Act, No. 2019-2 and Title 39 of the Alabama Code regardless if the requirement is explicitly detailed in the bid proposal or not. This bid shall be in effect from October 1st 2024 until September 30th 2025 covering any Proceed Orders issued by Escambia County during that time frame. This project will be eligible for a Certificate of Exemption as provided by ACT 2021-372. Once a proceed order is issued, the contractor shall have 5 days to submit the Form ST-EXC 1 to the County.

Sealed bids will be received by the Escambia County Commission at the Escambia County Courthouse until 10 AM Central Time on Wednesday, September 18th, 2024, and then publicly opened as soon thereafter as practicable. Award will be made at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Escambia County Commission. Only bids from contractors or material suppliers listed on the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) approved list of contractors and material suppliers will be accepted. All bids must be marked with the word "BID" on the outside of the bid package along with Bid Proposal for <u>ECB-HWA-01240828 Annual Paving, Striping, and Plant Mix Bid</u>, the bid date, and the Alabama General Contractor's License Number.

The contractor shall meet all Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) Bonding and Licensing requirements as well as all applicable laws, ordinances, and codes of the U.S. Government, the State of Alabama, any relevant municipality, and the COUNTY, and, specifically and without limitation, shall comply with all provisions of the Beason-Hammond Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, commonly referred to as the Immigration Act.

All bid items shall be placed in accordance with the bid items and specifications, current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications (non-metric edition), and any Supplemental Specifications approved by the Escambia County Engineer. This project is being advertised, let to contract, and administered by an awarding authority other than the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT). To the Escambia County Commission:

The undersigned shall give Escambia County at least 48 hours' notice in advance of performing work at any site once a Proceed Order has been issued by Escambia County. The undersigned must receive written permission to work on Saturdays, Sundays, or County recognized holidays 48 hours prior to such work commencing. Unless otherwise directed in writing by the County Engineer, the undersigned will be expected to begin work within 15 calendar days after issuance of the Proceed Order. The undersigned will be given a minimum of

as defined in the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, per Proceed Order. Each Proceed Order shall designate the number of working days or calendar days allowed. Should the undersigned fail to complete the project or projects specified in the Proceed Order within the working days or calendar days stipulated, liquidated damages shall be assessed as defined in section 108.10 in the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications or as amended by Special Provision.

A certified check, drawn on an Alabama Bank, or bid bond, for *\$10,000* made payable to the Escambia County Commission is enclosed as evidence of good faith. Within 15 days upon notification of bid award, the undersigned shall submit to Escambia County the contract documents, certificate of public liability insurance, certificate of poof of workman's compensation insurance, and business license. The undersigned shall provide to the County his/her Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) Vendor Identification Number as shown on the E-Verify Compliance Status List on the ALDOT website as proof of enrollment in E-Verify. Once a proceed order has been issued by the Escambia County, and before commencing any work under the bid, the low bidder shall provide a **performance bond** in the amount equal to 100% of the total estimated cost on any projects performed under this bid in accordance with the terms of the contract. In addition, before commencing any work under this bid, a **payment bond** shall also be provided by the low bidder in the amount of 50% of the total estimated cost on any projects performed under this bid.

The successful bidder shall be required to meet all post construction advertising requirements under the Rebuild Alabama Act, No. 2019-2 and Alabama Code Title 39. The undersigned shall submit the "Advertisement of Project Completion" to Escambia County immediately following the completion and acceptance of all work required, per Proceed Order. The County Engineer will submit the advertisement to the Association of County Commissions of Alabama (ACCA) to be posted on a website maintained by ACCA for a period of four consecutive weeks.

Upon completion and acceptance of all work required, the undersigned will be paid upon presentation of the following:

a. A properly executed and duly certified voucher for final payment.

b. A release of all claims and claims of liens against the awarding authority arising by virtue of the contract.

c. Proof of Advertisement of project completion (AL Code 39-1-1(f) requires a 30-day waiting period after the notice has run before final settlement can be made)

The undersigned agrees: Final payment will be made within 35 days after all the above requirements are met; Partial Payments, to be paid no more than monthly, for each Proceed Order will be provided under this contract; This project will be eligible for a Certificate of Exemption as provided by ACT 2021-372. Once a proceed order is issued, the contractor shall have 5 days to submit the Form ST-EXC 1 to the County. Retainage shall be withheld on each Proceed Order as required under Code of Alabama Section 39-2-12.

By submitting this proposal, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate the federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor, at its sole expense, shall obtain and maintain in full force the following insurance to protect the Contractor and the County Commission of Escambia County, Alabama (CCEC) at limits and coverages specified below. These limits and coverages specified are the minimum to be maintained and are not intended to represent the correct insurance needed to fully and adequately protect the Contractor.

All insurance will be provided by insurers licensed to conduct business in the State of Alabama and shall have a minimum A.M. Best rating of A- VII and must be acceptable to the CCEC. Self-insured plans and/or group funds not having an A.M. Best rating must be submitted to the CCEC for prior approval.

No work shall be performed until proof of compliance with the insurance requirements has been received by the CCEC.

The ISO Form CG 20 10 11 85 or a comparable form that is no more restrictive shall be required. The Additional Insured form MUST include the current Operations and Products/Completed Operations of the contractor. The naming of the additional insured does not obligate the additional insured to pay any premiums due.

- Aggregate limits to be on a "per project" basis OR an Owners and Contractors Protective Liability Policy shall be provided in the name of CCEC, the contractor and Subcontractors. Limits to be the same as above Commercial General Liability.

(c) <u>Automobile Liability</u>

Covering all Owned, Non-Owned, and Hired vehicles with a Combined single limit (bodily injury and property damage combined) of \$3,000,000 each accident. The policy shall name CCEC its officers, appointees, employees, and agents as an Additional Insured.

(d) Protection and Indemnity Insurance

If the contract involves work aboard an Owned, Non-Owned or Hired Vessel, Liability coverage in the amount of \$3,000,000 per occurrence shall be maintained.

(e) Indemnification and Liability

Under this section the term County shall include Escambia County, the Escambia County Commission, the officers, appointees, department heads, agents, and employees of the Escambia County Commission.

The County shall not be liable for any injury to the person or property of any person, firm, or corporation resulting directly or indirectly from Contractor's performance of this Contract, and the Contractor assumes full and complete responsibility, therefore.

The Contractor shall further indemnify the County and hold the County safe and harmless from any and all liability, lawsuits, judgments, attorney fees, and other costs incurred by the County in defending any claim or lawsuit made against the County by any person, firm, or corporation arising directly or indirectly out of any work performed by the Contractor pursuant hereto or any breach or alleged breach of duty or responsibility of the Contractor related thereto.

Waiver of Subrogation

The Workers Compensation Policy shall contain a Waiver of Subrogation in favor of the CCEC, its officers, appointees, employees, and agents.

Certificate of Insurance

A Certificate of Insurance evidencing the above minimum requirements must be provided to and accepted by the CCEC PRIOR to commencement of any work on the contract. Each policy shall be endorsed by the issuing insurer to provide thirty (30) days prior written notice of cancellation to the CCEC.

The Purchasing Agent of Escambia County, Alabama, is requesting sealed bids for purchase of the following items:

ANNUAL PAVING, STRIPING, AND ASPHALT PLANT MIX

NOTE: This bid will be effective beginning October 1, 2024 and ending September 30, 2025.

SPECIFICATIONS:

Specifications for materials and work performed shall meet the requirements set forth in the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (latest edition) and the ALDOT Special and Standard Highway Drawings (latest edition).

PLANT MIX QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Asphalt plant must be a permanent installation now in operation that will be open for production on a year-round basis in order to supply patch and paving materials to the county at any time needed.
- 2. The asphalt plant must produce and provide type mix the County requires at any time in any amount without delay.
- 3. The type mix required will be specified under Section 424 in the ALDOT Standard Specification for Highway Construction, current edition, and any applicable revisions or special provisions issued.
- 4. The specified mix will be purchased as needed, in any quantity (one ton or more), either FOB (your plant) and picked up by Escambia County forces, or per quantity range supplied and installed by contractor, at the pleasure of Escambia County, Alabama, through the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024 and ending September 30, 2025.
- 5. Bid price is required for Section 424 as mentioned in above paragraph. No substitutions in mix or material will be allowed under this contract.

- 6. The bid submitted shall state exact location of the plant, or plants, which will be utilized for performance in the event that the bid is accepted. Job mix formulas certified by ALDOT will be required for the 424 mixes being supplied to Escambia County. Any plant producing asphalt plant mix must be currently certified and maintain that Certification by Alabama Department of Transportation. Escambia County further requires that the asphalt plant be certified by ALDOT for all state work. Proof of Certification/Approval of plant by Alabama Department Transportation must be submitted with bid. In the event the successful bidder should fail to maintain certification of its plant any time after bid award and during the period of this bid, the Escambia County Commission shall be promptly notified.
- 7. Cost of transportation from Asphalt Plant to job site (including time of travel) and the location of the asphalt plant will be considered in determining the low bidder.
- 8. Each hot mix asphalt plant shall be equipped with a laboratory as specified under Section 410 in the ALDOT Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, current edition, and any applicable revisions or special provisions issued since that date.
