General Description

Coordinate and direct the planning, organization, control and implementation of local emergency management activities to protect the lives and property of the citizens of Escambia County.

Job Responsibilities

- Manage, operate and maintain the EOC.
- Coordinate, develop and implement the Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) for the county, including annual updates.
- Prepare and submit annual budget proposal and manage the agency's budget.
 Locate, secure, and administer grant funding from other agencies to supplement operations budget.
- Serve as Homeland Security point-of-contact for the county.
- Conduct presentations at schools, civic organizations, and other events to enhance community awareness and preparedness for potential disaster/emergency threats.
- Establish and maintain effective communications with local, tribal, state, and federal jurisdictions to promote interagency cooperation.
- Establish and maintain effective communications with local news media to quickly advise the public of emergency situations.
- Establish and maintain Mutual Aid Agreements with other agencies.
- Meet with staff from schools, nursing homes, and hospitals to assist in preparation of emergency plans for each facility.
- Coordinate distribution of assistance to citizens following disasters.
- Coordinate overall response functions with appropriate personnel.

Job Requirements

- High school diploma or GED and minimum of 2 years experience as an Emergency Management Director or equivalent position.
- Must be willing to relocate to Escambia County within six months of employment.
- Must meet Minimum Standards for Emergency Management Directors as established by the Alabama Emergency Management Agency within 2 years of employment.
- Travel and attendance at various training sessions conducted by AEMA, FEMA, and other agencies.

- Valid Alabama Driver License and good driving record.
- Good vision, hearing, and communications skills required. Ability to climb, stoop, kneel, reach, sit for extended periods and lift up to 25 lbs.
- Ability to work closely with representatives from local, state, tribal, federal, and private organizations, often during stressful situations for extended periods of time.

Starting salary: \$50,000 - \$70,000 depending upon qualifications.
